PERFORMING ARTS EMPOWERMENT VENTURE

2019-present

Founder, Young Artiste, Bengaluru, India (<u>www.youngartiste.com</u>)

Started a National competition for the Arts which evolved into Young Artiste, today India's largest online Arts education platform.

- Designed and launched the competition which garnered over 15,000 entries across 20 classical and contemporary music and dance forms.
- Assembled The top 100 winners were selected by an eminent jury including Ustad Amzad Ali Khan, Dr L Subramanian, Madhavi Mudgal and Aruna Sairam. These students received a scholarship and the opportunity to attend a mentorship program with some of India's finest musicians.
- In 2022, seeing the lack of arts education opportunities for learners from tier 2 and 3 markets, launched an online educational platform to provide free performing arts education. Currently have 7 YouTube educational channels with over 2000 video tutorials covering vocals, dance and instrumental music. The platform has amassed 4 mn viewers and 60,000 learners from over 300 cities of India.
- Created 7 channels offering comprehensive lessons and curriculum open to any learner are the following: Hindustani vocals, Indian vocals, Western vocals, Bollywood dance, Kathak, Guitar and Keyboard.

Research on the prevalence and impact of Dysmenorrhea

Researched and wrote a paper on "The prevalence and impact of Primary Dysmenorrhea on adolescent girls in India across income levels" has been guided by Prof Ravi Jasuja at Harvard Medical School and the paper has been accepted for presentation and publication at the World Conference on Gender and Women's Studies in London

- Conducted a primary survey amongst 270 school-going girls in two groups low -ncome and high-income schools.
- Findings point to a highly adverse impact of dysmenorrhea on girls and the need for teacher education interventions in low-income schools.
